NEWS FROM GRACE AND MAIN FELLOWSHIP IN DANVILLE!

We are so grateful for your prayers and partnership with our ministry over the years, and want to make sure you know that we could not do this work without you.

Ministry global in a pandemic has been a challenge for us, as I'm sure it has been for everyone else. While we have had to stop most of our in-person gatherings in order to protect the most vulnerable among us, we certainly have not taken a break from the work of bearing witness the love of Jesus and cultivating His beloved community in Danville. During this season. we have been working to provide hundreds of masks to our friends, neighbors, and community members, most of which were stitched together by Grace and Main leaders and community partners. These masks are washable and reusable, which was particularly helpful in the beginning of this crisis when protective equipment was difficult to find.

In addition to masks. Grace and Main has been providing transportation for folks grocery stores, medical appointments, the local food pantry, and many other places. The many hours spent riding in the car with some of our friends has created much needed time to check in with folks that we can't see every week. We have also continued our community meals as a "take-out" and "delivery" dinner, giving us even more opportunities to see how people are doing. In a time of profound anxiety and isolation, these checkins have been life giving for me, as I hope they have been for the folks I'm checking on.

The Grace and Main Urban Farm and Tool Library have continued to move forward this year. We received several mowers. trimmers. and chainsaw, as well as other tools from some of our supporters this year. These tools are consistently being borrowed, as working outside still seems to be pretty safe. We were glad to have a group of ladies from Oak Level in August who toured the farm and helped us start some cabbage seeds for the fall. This year was a catch-up year at the Farm as we sought to clean up from leaving several beds fallow last year during the stay-at-home order. Even though we only planted about half of our beds, we still produced over 100 pounds of food, and we began experimenting with some new, low-cost ways to create our own fertilizers.

The most exciting news from Grace and Main this year is also what we are looking forward to in 2022. This year, thanks to a grant from the CBF of Virginia and an award from the Danville Regional Foundation, Grace and Main was able to purchase a 4-unit apartment building in one of our neighborhoods. For many years, G & M has been providing radical hospitality in our homes, as well as supplementing rent and utilities as needed to help people stay in safe, reliable shelter. With

this apartment building, as well as a small house that was recently donated to the community, we are expanding our housing work to include transitional shelter and a cooperative ownership program that will help people who have not had access to home ownership begin to build equity toward permanent housing. This is one piece of a larger plan to try to reduce homelessness and make housing more affordable Danville. Keep an eye out for more news on this exciting new ministry!

We cannot thank you all enough for your support through prayers, volunteering, and giving over the last several years. We truly could not do this work without the faithfulness of partners like Oak Level Baptist Church.
