SHARING THE JOURNEY

Greetings in the Name above all names, Jesus Christ! As I sit here writing this, we have made it to the month of October; soon it will be Thanksgiving, Advent, and Christmas. We are at the end of another year. I think it's fitting that as this is the November/December newsletter, we should reflect first on what we're thankful for. Paul tells us in 1 Thessalonians 5:17: In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Paul exhorts us to give thanks in everything - we are not commanded to give thanks for everything. Who would give thanks for sickness or heartbreak or the like? No, we're commanded to give thanks IN everything. We may not always understand God's ways or even His means, but we can still give thanks in all things. Consider the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians 4:8-9: We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed... We echo the words of Isaiah: For unto us a child is born, unto us a Son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, the Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon His kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the Lord of Hosts will perform this (Isaiah 9:6-7). How wonderful it is to come to the time of year where we focus on our thankfulness to God for all His blessings and the time of celebrating the arrival of victory through Jesus Christ and the awaiting for His promised return and rule.
